The specialist clinic for allergy-immunology, immunodermatology and pulmonology is an extremely specific clinical field in which diagnostic skills and procedures must inevitably follow international guidelines and detailed protocols that are shared as widely as possible. This approach ensures the highest possible reliability and reproducibility of the results obtained, in order to provide patients who attend these clinics with an objective diagnostic outcome that is comparable between the various specialist centres nationwide.

In this context, it is therefore essential that all key players, doctors and specialist nurses, acquire precise skills relating to the various diagnostic procedures.

Specialised allergy-immunological, immuno-dermatological and pneumological diagnostics are carried out using extremely diverse methods that require in-depth knowledge of allergic and immunological mechanisms and respiratory pathophysiology.

Specifically, the aim of this course is to acquire skills in standardised procedures for performing the following diagnostic methods:

- > Indications and contraindications for performing patch tests
- > Preparing patients for skin biopsies
- > Indications and performance of respiratory function tests (spirometry and FeNO measurement)
- > Indications and contraindications for performing drug tests, with particular attention to the management of oral tolerance/provocation tests and skin and intradermal tests

In order to ensure a more comprehensive acquisition of skills, the course will conclude with a practical session on performing allergy prick tests and respiratory function tests.
